SUMMER I.D. STICKERS FOR <u>CONTINUING</u> GRADUATE STUDENTS

- Summer stickers will no longer be issued.
- Students who were registered Spring quarter 2003 will have access to university facilities such as library services, transit services, and food services. RIMAC is available to all continuing students upon payment of a \$25.00 summer fee.

SUMMER 2003 STUDENT HEALTH SERVICES AND HEALTH INSURANCE

During the summer, health care is available to all continuing students upon payment of a summer fee. Spring quarter GSHIP (Graduate Student Health Insurance Plan) provides payment of the summer fee for students covered by the plan. Continuing graduate students waiving out of the GSHIP plan may be seen upon payment of the Student Health Service (SHS) summer access fee. The access fee is \$72 for each Summer Session.

SESSION IJune 16 – August 2SESSION IIAugust 4 – September 19

June graduates not covered by the GSHIP plan may use the SHS on a fee-for-service basis. The SHS summer fees <u>do not</u> include health insurance.

Summer services include Physician and Nurse Practitioner (NP) Appointments, First Aid, Urgent Care, Women's Clinic, Nutrition Visits, and in-house labs. Most services now are available on an appointment basis by calling (858) 534-8090. There is a limited walk-in Urgent Care Clinic for urgent problems.
